WE LOVE GOD BECAUSE HE FIRST LOVED US

When you were born you were given a name and eventually you were given a birth certificate and other documentation to mark your birth and your identity.

Well when you give your life to Christ scripture says you are, "born again" and that rebirth also comes with a new identity. You are now a son or daughter of a God.

This new identity is proved by a certificate or an identification number – no it is based in and founded upon God's love for you.

His perfect love is the basis of your new identity as a believer. In fact, **John 3:16 NIV** says – **16** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

This is not a cheap love, it is a costly love. It cost God the life of his son Jesus, whom God allowed to die for our sins so that we could be sons and daughters free to live a new life.

Just because someone is existing doesn't mean that they're living.

Are you experiencing life the way God intended for you to live as described in John 10:10?

The reality of life is that there are only three ways to live: sinking, surviving, or thriving. Jesus saves us from a life of sinking and surviving so that we can experience a new life with the power to thrive.

We believe experiencing the abundant life requires that we don't just allow Jesus to save us, but to us *lead us*.

SALVATION

This life begins with salvation.

• Salvation gives us the **CAPACITY** to live life as God intended.

Salvation means to be:

Rescued, Delivered, and Recovered

Why do we need to be rescued, delivered, etc.? Because

• God's way is not just right, it's best!

Romans 10:9 (NIV)

9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

This scripture teaches us that salvation requires our heart and mouth to agree that we need a relationship with God. We must then declare specifically that Jesus is Lord, because for God to save your life He has to lead it.

 Salvation is not a destination, it's a <u>door</u> to a new life under new management.

SAVED FROM SIN

We are saved from:

• The Problem of Sin – Impulses that are self-destructive.

This means that even though we have them, they no longer have us. We now have the power to resist this flawed nature.

• The Penalty of Sin – distance between us and God.

Isaiah 59:2 (NIV) 2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.

Our sins don't change our relationship with God, but they do affect our fellowship with Him. Distance now and eternally has been rectified by Jesus.

 The Power of Sin – God's Spirit in the believer enables us to no longer be dominated or controlled by the habits and behavior patterns that controlled and dominated us previously.

We are no longer slaves to sin, because Jesus has rescued, delivered, and recovered us from that.

SAVED FOR GOD'S PROMISES

Salvation has a benefits package! Do you know what benefits you receive with your salvation?

John 10:28-29 (NIV)

28 I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. **29** My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.

We are saved for the Purpose of God. The purpose of God is twofold:

- **Function** involves us discovering what we're supposed to do.
- <u>Family</u> involves who we become, and who we become is impacted by who we're around.

We are not just saved for function, but we're also saved for family. The word the bible uses in the New Testament for spiritual family is church. Rock City Church is the spiritual family that God wants to connect you with to become all that He's created you to be.

Without spiritual growth there are some promises we cannot experience. In this next section let's learn how we are supposed to grow within our spiritual family.

SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES

Without spiritual growth there are some blessings, promises, and opportunities we cannot experience.

Galatians 4:1 (NIV)

1 What I am saying is that as long as an heir is underage, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate.

Galatians 4 is teaching us that – if you can't grow, you can't go to the next level.

The Bible gives us the way in which we must grow.

- Physical growth happens automatically.
- Spiritual growth requires intentionally.

As believers God has designed the church to be a place where we can all grow in our spiritual discipline. It should mirror the practices and progress of Christ's *disciples*.

In the next section you will find four categories of Spiritual Disciplines and a brief teaching on each. Please take time to review and implement these into your daily life.

DON'T DO LIFE ALONE

Purpose doesn't require us to be perfect, but it does require us to be free. True freedom is cultivated in the context of accountability, intimacy, and transparency or in other words... Family!

Proverbs 13:20 (NLT)

20 Walk with the wise and become wise; associate with fools and get in trouble.

4 Keys to Praying Effectively

Pray Sincerely

 The purpose of prayer is to reach the ear of the Father, not to impress Him.

• Pray Simply

The strength is not in the length of your prayers.

Pray Consistently

Nothing grows or works properly without consistency.

Pray Persistently.

 This is the ability and willingness to pray in the face of opposition

Luke 11:8 (NIV)

8 I tell you, even though he will not get up and give you the bread because of friendship, yet because of your shameless audacity he will surely get up and give you as much as you need.

Core Value: We Are Prayerful

We believe in *constant prayer* which means we pray early, often and about everything (Luke 18:1, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)

The A.C.T.S. Prayer Model

- Adoration
 - o adore who God is to you.
- Confession
 - o confess your sins and how you feel.
- Thanksgiving
 - thank God for your past, present, and future.
- Supplication
 - ask God to supply whatever you need.

If you find yourself struggling in your prayer life, implement some of these rhythms as a way to get on or stay on track.

EXPRESSING GOD'S WORTH

John 4:23-24 (NIV) 23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. **24** God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."

Worship is how we express God's worth and we believe that we were created to worship God.

Attendance

• It is possible to be in a place physically, but not mentally or emotionally. When we come before God, we must honor Him with our full attention.

Actions

• The Bible provides us with multiple ways to worship God and while won't won't all do the same thing, but we should all do something.

WAYS TO STUDY GOD'S WORD

Finding a good place to start reading the bible would be:

- The Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John)
- Proverbs
- Ecclesiastes

SOAP Study Method

Scripture - you physically write out the scripture.....you'll be amazed that what God will reveal to you just by taking the time to slow down and actually write out what you are reading!

Observation - what do you see in the verses that you're reading? Who is the audience? Is there a repetition of words? What words stand out to you?

Application - this is when God's Word becomes personal. What is God saying to me today? How can I apply what I just read to my own personal life? What changes do I need to make? Is there an action that I need to take?

Prayer - Pray God's Word back to Him. If He has revealed something to you during this time in His Word, pray about it. Confess if He has revealed some sin that is in your life.

SESSION TWO: LOVE PEOPLE

FREE INDEED

An essential part of the ministry of Jesus, is the ministry of liberation.

 John 8:36 (NIV) 36 So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

EMOTIONAL FREEDOM

It's one thing to have emotions, but it's another thing for our emotions to have us. Our feelings should be indicators, not dictators. It is important that we are not controlled by our emotions and pursue emotional freedom.

• Emotional Freedom comes from Inner Healing.

Psalm 147:3 (NIV) 3 He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

 Every person may not have a broken heart, but we're all brokenhearted.

Meaning that all of hearts have **imperfections**, **injuries**, **or issues** that we need God to heal and make whole. There are areas of our inner life we need God to heal and just because it isn't hurting, doesn't mean it isn't broken.

EMOTIONAL FREEDOM

EMOTIONAL FREEDOM EXPLORED

Jeremiah 17:9 (NIV) 9 "The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?"

In other words, our heart is deceitful; so, our heart can be broken without us even knowing it is broken. When we go through traumatic experiences, or when we don't get the love/support we need (particularly in our childhood years), a scab forms on our hearts The Bible calls it a *heart of stones*.

- There is some **Badness** that comes from **Brokenness**.
- Some badness doesn't get fixed until some brokenness gets healed.

Hebrews 12:15 (NIV) 15 See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many.

 The heart is arguably the greatest blind spot in most believer's life, with many of us not knowing that some of our hang-ups are connected to our heart healing.

EMOTIONAL NEEDS ASSESSMENT

WHAT NEEDS WERE NOT MEET?

There are 10 needs that every human being needs, failure to receive them will cause an emptiness in your soul; a longing for another to fulfill what you did not receive.

As you can see, each need has its own internal measuring glass. When that emotional need is met, the glass is full. When the need is not met, the glass is empty.

It is when the glass is empty that the enemy comes along and fills it with lies, which must be dealt with for complete healing.

With each glass, take a pen and fill in each glass according to the level of your met need. If you received a lot of respect as a child, fill that glass to the top. If you only received a little respect, fill only a little of the glass. Do the same for the other glasses.

FORGIVENESS

A key to inner healing is **forgiveness**.

This is the only way to stop the person who hurt you from continuing to hurt you, because forgiveness is the gift that you give to yourself!

Let's explore forgiveness together.

WALKING IN FORGIVENESS

WHAT IS FORGIVENESS

Here is what forgiveness is not:

- Forgiveness does NOT mean you excuse the behavior of the person.
- Forgiveness does NOT mean you have to reconcile the relationship.
- Forgiveness does NOT mean that you allow someone to continue in dysfunctional behavior.
- Forgiveness does NOT mean that you live without boundaries.
- Forgiveness does NOT mean to forget.

Forgiveness means to **PARDON**.

• Because God has forgiven me, I'm going to forgive others.

It is important to know that the person who hurt you can't heal you. Therefore we must release them (write off as bad debt) what they did so God can heal you from the hurt you experienced for their offense.

WALKING IN FORGIVENESS

WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT FORGIVENESS

Forgiving others is an important part of the healing process. When someone's actions have hurt us, we release them to God through forgiveness.

Let's read a few scriptures together on forgiveness and discuss them:

- Ephesians 4:32 (NIV) 32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- Matthew 6:12 (NIV) 12 And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
- Colossians 3:13 (NIV) 13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.
- Luke 6:37 (NIV) 37 "Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

KEYS TO KINGDOM MANAGEMENT

Matthew 25:21 NIV 21 "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'

FINANCIAL FREEDOM

Jesus teaches us to view our resources VERTICALLY.

• Why? Because our perception manages our performance.

Luke 16:11 11 So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches?

- When we realize that there are things that matter more than money, we won't put MONEY before those things.
- To view money vertically also means to see money as a resource and not as the SOURCE.

We must see ourselves as a **STEWARD** and not an **OWNER** of our money. Whatever we have, God gave it to us.

 Not only must we manage money vertically, but we must also manage money WISELY.

TITHING

The word tithe means TENTH. The tithe is the heart test. Tithing is a universal principle that we see all throughout scripture.

What is the Tithe?

The word tithe means tenth. God desires that the believer set aside the first tenth of his or her income for Him. (Malachi 3:6-12, Leviticus 27:30, Matthew 23:23)

The Reasons we Tithe?

- We Tithe because it reveals our heart. Matthew 6:19-24
- We Tithe because it gives God honor. Proverbs 3:1-2, 9
- We Tithe because it accelerates the vision of Rock City

Where do we Tithe?

You are to tithe at the storehouse or the local church that you are connected to and that feeds you, spiritually, every week.

What is the Offering?

The offering is a gift that is Over And Above the tithe. The offering is an above and beyond gift (Malachi 3:8).

GIVING IS BIBLICAL

Abel Committed It

And Abel also brought an offering—fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock. The Lord looked with favor on Abel and his offering, Genesis 4:4 NIV

Abraham Commenced It

And praise be to God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand." Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything. Genesis 14:20 NIV

Jacob Continued It

and this stone that I have set up as a pillar will be God's house, and of all that you give me I will give you a tenth." Genesis 28:22 NIV

Moses Commanded It

Every tithe of the herd and flock—every tenth animal that passes under the shepherd's rod—will be holy to the Lord. Leviticus 27:32 NIV

Malachi Confirmed It

Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. Malachi 3:10 NIV

Jesus Commended It

"Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices—mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law—justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former. Matthew 23:23 NIV

ROCK STEADY CHALLENGE 90-DAY GOD FIRST LIFESTYLE

God Will Receive the First Day Of Every Week.

Sunday is the Lord's day. It's the day in which we worship him for allowing us to experience another week. We can't expect him to bless the week if we don't give him the first. Some people skip worship to have a great Sunday not realizing that it's better to have half a Sunday and a great week, than to have a whole Sunday and a horrible week.

God Will Receive the First Minutes Of Every Day.

Even if we don't engage in lengthy devotions, the first person we should speak to and engage with when we wake up is God. We can't expect him to bless the day if we don't give him the first of it.

God Will Receive the First Of All Our Increase.

Tithing seems to be misunderstood as dues to be paid as opposed to an expression of God being first. Tithing doesn't mean God is first, God being first means you tithe! Whenever we experience increase we should ensure that the first goes to God.

- 1. The first person you think about when you wake up
- 2. The first person you think about when you receive income
- 3. The first person you give your free time to, is really an indication of who has first place in your heart.

SESSION THREE: MAKE A DIFFERENCE

It is our hope is that you take a step towards understanding how your uniquely designed personality, coupled with the spiritual gifts God has given you, help reveal a fulfilling pathway to purpose for you. Proverbs 25:2 says it is God's privilege to conceal things and our privilege to discover them. Together, let's discover all that God has planned for our generation and make a positive difference for the Kingdom.

- For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

 Jeremiah 29:11
- For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.
 Ephesians 2:10

THE GOAL OF THIS CLASS:

To discover how my **DESIGN** helps to reveal my **DESTINY**.

To discover the amazing **POTENTIAL** of my life.

"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and *greater works than these he will do;* because I go to the Father." John 14:12 (NASB)

Purpose is the compilation of the reasons for the creation or existence of a thing. Sadly, most people incorrectly assume that their purpose is a thing erroneously attaching their identity to a thing.

- Not realizing that God did not just create us for a reason, but for Reasons.
- Many of us think about purpose in the spiritual area, but God has called us to do purpose in <u>every area</u> of our lives.

SESSION THREE: MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Purpose is twofold:

<u>Universal Purpose</u> – There are parts of our purpose as a believer that we all share. This is the responsibilities that God has given to every believer.

<u>Unique Purpose</u> – This is where we make unique contributions to the world utilizing the spiritual gifts, talents, and acquired skills that God has given us.

Our Unique Purpose include three areas:

- NATURAL TALENTS These are natural abilities that we were born with.
- ACQUIRED SKILLS These are skills you had to learn in order to survive or thrive.
- **SPIRITUAL GIFTS** These are special abilities that the Holy Spirit distributes to believers so that may carry out God's work.
